

## SUMMER FUN RUN SCHEDULE

JCAC will be hosting our Summer Fun Runs this summer at the Cholla Patch (15<sup>th</sup> Avenue, just north of Happy Valley Road, see directions under “Classes” on the JCAC website) on **Tuesday** nights, along with “mini seminars” on some Thursday nights.

Summer Fun Runs will start at 7:15 p.m., should allow everyone to get, at a minimum, two runs in each and will end no later than 9:30 p.m. Advanced and Novice sides will run simultaneously, with appropriate versions of the same event being set up most nights. It is assumed those running Advanced are familiar with the rules of any given event; Novice will have instruction in rules and strategy.

Some Tuesdays, there will be distinct events on each side of the field. If your dog is experienced enough, you may run each side once, or just run one event twice. Getting more than two runs any given night will depend upon time available and attendance.

You can attend any or all Tuesday Fun Runs, pay per night or at a discounted package rate for all 10 nights. The cost is as follows (per dog, per night): \$8 for JCAC members, \$10 for non-members. Package rate (per dog, payable the first or second night): \$60 for members, \$80 for non-members. As always, instructors run free.

The Thursday night mini-seminars will start at 7:00 p.m. and run until about 9:30 p.m. Price will be \$10 per dog per mini-seminar. These are open to all JCAC students who have completed at least the Foundation class, unless otherwise noted.

Per JCAC policy, Fun Runs and Mini-Seminars are for JCAC students **only**.

All parking must be contained within the walls of the Cholla Patch. We ask your cooperation in parking efficiently to allow for the most cars. You may want to consider meeting a friend and parking one vehicle at a nearby shopping center if the parking situation gets too crowded. Thank you for your consideration.

Here is the tentative JCAC summer schedule (subject to change):

**6/10/08 (Tuesday)** - AKC sanctioned match. This match is for the licensing of Kachina Kennel Club to do agility. Your dog will need to be ready to, or close to ready to, compete in AKC. A premium will be made available at a later time.

**6/19/08 (Thursday)**- Mini-seminar - weave poles / Hoopers. We will do some weave pole drills at this seminar for dogs who are having trouble weaving, or finding entrances to the weaves. On the other side of the field, we will set up a Hoopers course.

**6/24/08 Fun Run #1 (Tuesday)** - Touch N Go in Advanced ring/ Tunnelers in Novice ring.

**6/26/08 (Thursday)** - Mini-seminar - Tight turns / wraps. This mini-seminar will focus on

practicing tight turns and “wraps”. Open to dogs who have completed the Beginner II class.

**7/1/08 Fun Run #2 (Tuesday)** - FAST courses (NOTE - fast is the AKC class which features a distance challenge)

**7/8/08 Fun Run #3 (Tuesday)** - Jumpers courses

**7/15/08 Fun Run #4 (Tuesday)** - Weavers in Advanced ring/ Touch N Go in Novice ring

**7/22/08 Fun Run #5 (Tuesday)** - Chances courses

**7/29/08 Fun Run #6 (Tuesday)** - Touch N Go in Advanced ring/ Tunnelers in Novice ring.

**8/5/08 Fun Run #7 (Tuesday)** - Snooker courses

**8/12/07 Fun Run #8 (Tuesday)** - Gamblers courses

**8/14/08 (Thursday)** Mini-seminar - Front and rear crosses. This mini-seminar will focus on practicing front crosses and rear crosses. Open to all students who have completed the Beginner II class.

**8/19/07 Fun Run #9 (Tuesday)** - Jumpers with Weaves in Advanced class/ Jumpers in Novice Class

**8/26/07 Fun Run #10 (Tuesday)** - FAST courses

**8/28/08 (Thursday)** Mini-seminar - Distance work. This mini-seminar will focus on working distance, both basic skills and practicing some more advanced distance exercises.

During the month of September, JCAC will host Nationals Practice at the Cholla Patch, open to any dog (whether training with JCAC or not) who is attending and participating in one of the upcoming National Championships – NADAC, ASCA, AKC Invitational, USDAA.
