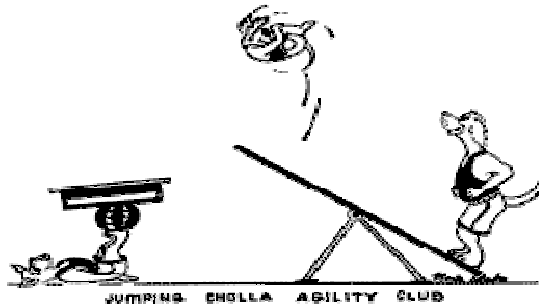

CHECK-IN

*****Check is required only for dogs who need to be measured.*****

Dogs who require measuring must check in and be measured. **Measuring is not optional, if a dog is not measured, it is not eligible to run; don't miss your measure-in time**

- Running order is determined alphabetically. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will be separated if possible.
- All Exhibitors for a given class should be present at ringside at least one-half hour prior to the start of the scheduled classes for walk through and briefing.
- Any dog and handler not present when called will be ineligible to run.

REFUNDS

There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.

A withdrawal from the competition after the closing date due to a bitch coming into season after the closing date will be eligible for a refund up to 75% of the total entry fee paid.

No entry fee refunded if the trial cannot open or completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire an act of God, public emergency and act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

MOVE-UPS

Move-ups, changes, or corrections will accept in writing only (or e-mail to ahammer9@cox.net) through April 14 at 6:00PM. **No changes/corrections will be accepted after this date.** This includes any changes that need to be made because of incorrect entry on trial secretary's part. Please read your confirmations carefully prior to April 14th. There will be move-ups from Saturday April 17 to Sunday April 18. Completed move up forms are due to Ann Hammersly on Saturday April 17th by end of last run.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Exhibitors through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of the trial.

- Dogs must have valid NADAC registration numbers before entries will be accepted. The application for a NADAC registration number is available at www.nadac.com.
- Please double-check your entry form to ensure it is filled out completely and correctly. Entry may be returned if missing information is critical to entry. Examples: Skilled or Proficient is not circled or if the jump height is not listed or no NADAC #.
- We will provide electronic confirmations to all entrants who include their email addresses with their entry. If you included and email address, your conformation will be sent as an attachment (PDF) in an email. **It is your responsibility to make sure ahammer9@cox.net is allowed by your spam blocker or to change options that strip attachment from emails.**
- Confirmation of entry will be sent to the address provided on the entry form (e-mail or snail mail) after closing date. **If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the confirmation within 7 days of the closing date, contact the Trial Secretary**
- **Checks not honored by the bank DOES NOT constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$35 service charge for bank returned checks.**
- All dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring.

- No Alcoholic Beverages allowed on the show site.
- Ribbons/Coupons will be awarded to first through fourth places in all jump heights except for Chances. Since Chances is a pass/fail game, placements are not given. Ribbons/Coupons awarded for those finishing a title and qualifying Ribbons/Coupons awarded for those achieving a qualifying score.
- The sponsoring club will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result is accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made
- Rubberized surfaces are used on all contact obstacles. Weave poles have 24" spacing.

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the files section of the NADACagility@yahoo.com list within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. The trial results will remain on the list for at least thirty (30) days. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the www.NADACagility@yahoo.com list and set your settings to "no mail". You will be able to view trial results and check for any possible discrepancies, without receiving list mail. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

This trial will be held under the current rules and regulations of NADAC with Jumping Chollas Agility Club as the sponsoring club. NADAC rules will prevail. Exhibitors through submission of entry acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations and agree to abide by all the rules in effect at the time of this trial. The trial committee has the right to refuse entry to anyone including anyone not in good standing with NADAC

DOGS MUST BE REGISTERED AND HAVE A VALID REGISTRATION NUMBER BEFORE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

Current Jump Height Table, Breed Exemption List, description of classes, levels and divisions and equipment descriptions are included in the current Exhibitors Handbook.

PROFICIENT / SKILLED CATEGORIES:

Each class will be split into two categories, Proficient and Skilled.

Skilled Category, dogs jump 4" lower than indicated by the current jump height table. (No dog can jump less than 4"). Dogs entered in the Skilled Category may incur 5 or fewer faults, (course/time) and earn a 5 pt. qualifying round in Regular agility.

Proficient category a qualifying round must be clean; no courses faults and no time faults

NON-JUMPING CLASSES – VETERAN HANDLER:

Handlers aged 60 yrs. or older may opt to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This division is for handlers only. When entering this division, handlers must enter all classes with all dogs as a veteran handler.

Jump Heights

Dogs entered in the Proficient Category must jump at the minimum jump height specified by the following table. Dogs entering the Skilled Category MUST jump one jump height lower than the heights listed in the table, although no dog shall jump lower than 4".

All dogs must jump their valid jump height as determined by their Category and Division and may not jump higher.

As the table shows, there are five Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", 20", 20+. There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16". There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Veterans and Junior Handler dogs must jump their valid jump height and may not jump higher; thus, a Vets or JH dog may not jump higher than 16" in the Proficient category and no higher than 12" in the Skilled category.

There is no 4" Standard Division jump height in Proficient; the 4" Proficient height is for veteran dogs/handlers, disabled handlers, and junior handlers only. In the Skilled category, 8" dogs may jump 4" as their standard jump height. No dog may jump lower than 4".

OVERNIGHT RV PARKING

- No hook-ups are available You MAY park an RV next to the building but NO ONE may plug their RV into the electricity on the building for any reason.
- Generator must be off between 10:00 pm and 6 am.
- Exhibitors will be responsible for cleanup of their parking space. No discharging of gray water on premises.

DIRECTIONS TO FACILITY: Coors Event Center – Yavapai County Fairgrounds. The Yavapai County Fairgrounds is on HWY 89A a few miles East of Prescott Valley, AZ.

From Phoenix (or Flagstaff) - Take I-17 North(or South) to Cordes Jct. Then take HWY 69 to Dewey. Turn right on FAIN ROAD (across from Prescott Country Club) continue to Hwy 89A, turn right on Hwy 89A, go a few miles, then right at Yavapai County Fairgrounds.

From Ashfork – Take HWY 89 South to HWY 89A. Turn left (East) on HWY 89A, go several miles. Stay on Hwy 89A. Turn right at Yavapai Country Fairgrounds.

Once you've turned in to the Fairgrounds make a left at the road by the RV Park. The trial will be located in the COORS Building.

This event will be held indoors on dirt. Parking and covered crating areas are available.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, Inc., and their members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
2. Exhibitor/owner agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
3. Exhibitor/owner certifies that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
5. Exhibitor/owner release NADAC, (including their officers, directors, employees, and members), Jumping Chollas Agility Club (including its officers, agents, and employees), and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Exhibitor/owner hereby assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the afore-mentioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
6. Exhibitor understands there is a returned check fee of \$35.
