## **DAILY FEES AND PACKAGE RATES TRIAL**

Junior Handlers - All runs - \$5 per run      Junior Handler Saturday Package \$15: Junior Handler Sunday Package \$15  
Sunday – All runs for adult handlers- \$11 per run.      The 12<sup>th</sup> paid adult handler run from a household is free.

If you have never done NADAC before, or it's been over 3 years since you have done NADAC, we are offering a "welcome to the venue" deal where you can enter all classes Sunday for 50% OFF your entry. This offer is only valid for your first time at a NADAC trial as a handler or if you haven't done NADAC in over 3 years. New dogs under a handler who has done NADAC in the last three years are not eligible.

## **CHECK-IN**

\*\*\*IF you include a readable photocopy of your dog's NADAC card (for max height dogs) OR Permanent Jump Height Card, with your entry; you **will** be automatically checked in. This does **NOT** apply to dogs who need to be measured.\*\*\*

**Each Day** Measure in will be between **7:15 and 7:45 am only**, for those who didn't send in a copy of NADAC card / Permanent Jump Height Card OR dogs needing to be measured. **Measuring is not optional for dogs in the proficient category.** If a dog is required to be measured but is not measured, it is not eligible to run. Don't miss your check-in/measure-in time. Dogs running in Skilled need not be measured.

**Important:** During the trial please validate your dog's NADAC registration number on the posted copy of the results at the trial. Report any discrepancies to the trial secretary. **It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to verify their NADAC registration number.**

ORDER OF RUNS WILL BE SENT WITH THE CONFIRMATIONS

- Running order is determined alphabetically. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will be separated if possible.
- All Exhibitors for a given class should be present at ringside at least one-half hour prior to the start of the scheduled classes for walk through and briefing.
- Any dog and handler not present when called will be ineligible to run.

## **MOVE-UPS**

Move-ups or changes will be accepted by e-mail to [ahammer9@cox.net](mailto:ahammer9@cox.net) through February 9, 2018. Please read your confirmations carefully prior to February 9<sup>th</sup>. Changes made after that time that are not the fault of the trial secretary will be done for a \$10 fee.

## **REFUNDS**

There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.

A withdrawal from the competition after the closing date due to a bitch coming into season after the closing date will be eligible for a refund up to 75% of the total entry fee paid.

No entry fee refunded if the trial cannot open or completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire an act of God, public emergency and act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

**Exhibitors through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of the trial.**

- Dogs must have valid NADAC registration numbers before entries will be accepted. The application for a NADAC registration number is available at [www.nadac.com](http://www.nadac.com).
- Please double-check your entry form to ensure it is filled out completely and correctly. Entry may be returned if information that is critical to the entry is missing.
- We will provide electronic confirmations to all entrants who include their email addresses with their entry. If you included an email address, your confirmation will be sent as an attachment (PDF) in an email. **It is your responsibility to make sure [ahammer9@cox.net](mailto:ahammer9@cox.net) is allowed by your spam blocker or to change options that strip attachment from emails.**
- Confirmation of entry will be sent to the address provided on the entry form (e-mail or snail mail) after closing date. **If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the confirmation within 3 days of the closing date, contact the Trial Secretary**
- Please review this confirmation carefully. If there are any changes that need to be made because of incorrect entry on trial secretary's part, you must notify Trial Secretary prior to **February 9<sup>th</sup>**. Corrections need not be made the day of the show.
- **Checks not honored by the bank DO NOT constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$35 service charge for bank returned checks.**
- All dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring.
- No Alcoholic Beverages allowed on the show site.
- Rosettes/Coupons will be awarded to first through fourth places in all jump heights in all classes except Chances, which is a pass/fail class. Rosettes/Coupons awarded for those finishing a title and qualifying Rosettes/Coupons awarded for those achieving a qualifying score.
- The sponsoring club will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result is accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made
- Rubberized surfaces are used on all contact obstacles. Weave poles have 24" spacing. No shade or water is available at the site – please bring sufficient water for you and your dog(s).

**We reserve the right to refuse entries**

**IMPORTANT.** Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the [www.NADACForum.com](http://www.NADACForum.com) within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the Forum by going to [www.NADACForum.com](http://www.NADACForum.com) and submitting your request. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

**Levels.** Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be recorded by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

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## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Below is a brief summary of NADAC rules. Please refer to [www.nadac.com](http://www.nadac.com) for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.

Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.

The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.

\*\*Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted.

### **PROFICIENT / SKILLED CATEGORIES:**

Each class will be split into two categories, Proficient and Skilled.

Skilled Category, dogs jump 4" lower than indicated by the current jump height table. (No dog can jump less than 4").

Dogs entered in the either category may incur 5 or fewer faults, (course/time) and earn a 5 pt. qualifying round in Regular agility.

## Jump Heights

Dogs entered in the Proficient Category must jump at the minimum jump height specified by the following table. Dogs entering the Skilled Category MUST jump one jump height lower than the heights listed in the table, although no dog shall jump lower than 4". All dogs must jump their valid jump height as determined by their Category and Division and may not jump higher.

As the table shows, there are five Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", 20", 20+. There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16". There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Veterans and Junior Handler dogs **must** jump their valid jump height and may not jump higher; thus, a Vets or JH dog may not jump higher than 16" in the Proficient category and no higher than 12" in the Skilled category.

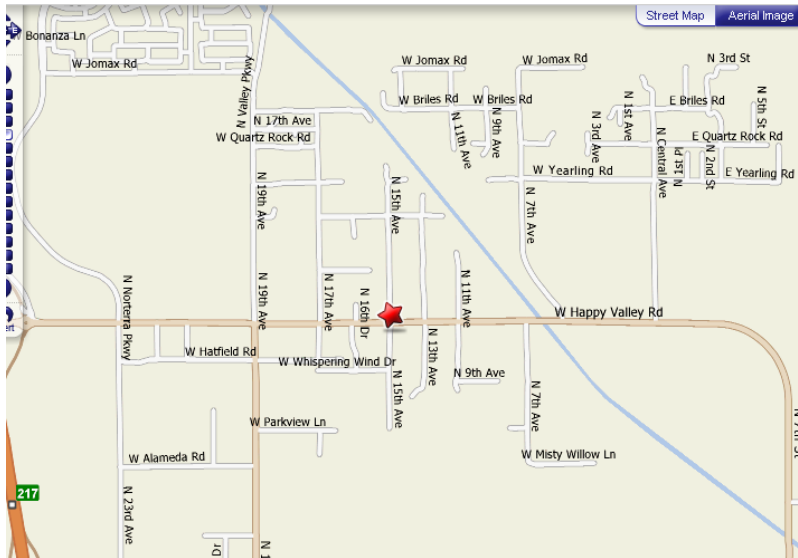
As of January-2014: Dogs must enter the Veterans Division after their 9th birthday. Dogs must enter the Skilled Category, Veterans Division after their 12th birthday.

There is no 4" Standard Division jump height in Proficient; the 4" Proficient height is for veteran dogs/handlers, disabled handlers, and junior handlers only. In the Skilled category, 8" dogs may jump 4" as their standard jump height. No dog may jump lower than 4".

## SITE INFORMATION

This event will be held outdoors on artificial turf surface with **no** shade or water. You will need to provide shade and water for your dog(s). Note that NOTHING can be staked on the turf!

25128 N. 15th Ave., Phoenix. From Happy Valley Rd. turn north onto 15th Ave., which is a dirt road. Please drive slowly and park **inside** the block walled area at the Cholla Patch, or you may park along the NORTH wall outside of the facility. No parking is permitted along 15th Ave. Note that carpooling will be necessary for the Sunday part of the show!
