Trial Fees

Adult runs \$13 per run, with the 12th paid adult run from a single household free, Junior Handler runs \$7 per run or \$120 for the weekend. No more than 50% of trial fees can come from coupons/Jumping Bucks.

Make checks payable to JCAC.

A one-time 50% "welcome to NADAC" discount may be used for the first NADAC show entered by any handler, OR for a handler who has not competed in NADAC for the last three years.

Entry Limits:

This trial is limited to 250 runs Friday, 500 runs each Saturday and Sunday

Move-ups, changes, or corrections will be accepted by e-mail to sueboe@cox.net

through March 10, 2024. Please read your confirmations carefully.

Day of Show / Late Entries:

Late entries (received after March 7, 2024) will be accepted with a \$10 flat surcharge per dog if room is available. No day of show entries. Additional runs for a dog already entered are accepted until the course in question is built and numbered, if room is available.

Refunds:

There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after one week before the show or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.

A withdrawal from the competition after one week before the show due to a bitch coming into season after the closing date will be eligible for a refund up to 75% of the total entry fee paid.

No entry fee refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency and act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Ribbons/Coupons will be awarded to first through fourth places in all jump heights except for Chances. Since Chances is a pass/fail game, placements are not given. Ribbons/Coupons awarded for those finishing a title and qualifying Ribbons/Coupons awarded for those achieving a qualifying score.

Please let the Show Chair and Secretary know if your dog may earn a NATCH or V-NATCH at this show.

Parking

There is parking and plenty of crating areas at this site.

Shade is limited. Restrooms and running water are available.

Dogs cannot be officially measured before 2 years old but must be measured by the time they are competing in Elite.

JUMP HEIGHTS

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20".

There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil
 disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause
 beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. https://www.nadac.com/register-your-dog/
- A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may
 cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility
 obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No food, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring. Food or a small non-audible toy can be in a secure container (ziplock bag is acceptable) in your pocket during your run but it cannot be used during your run, nor can you indicate to the dog it is there. All handlers may bring a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run. Please read the Exhibitors Handbook for more information about toys and training in the ring.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

- No coupons can be used with this online option. However, you can still get the package discount and junior handler pricing through this online entry.
- Emailed entries to the show secretary will only be accepted from trial workers/committee members
 who have a free entry for their dog(s). Payment for their additional dogs must come immediately
 please.
- Failure to pay required fees will exclude the exhibitor from future Jumping Chollas shows
- Note that a PayPal refund, if allowed, will be 90% of the original payment due to the fees charged by PayPal.

Agility Gate

- We will also be using Agility Gate instead of paper gate sheets, and the code for this trial will be

- Running order is determined alphabetically. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will be separated if possible.
- All Exhibitors for a given class should be present at ringside at least one-half hour prior to the start of the scheduled classes for walk through and briefing.
- Any dog and handler not present when called will be ineligible to run.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members) and Jumping Chollas Agility Club (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons

Junior Handlers - \$7 per run, Junior Handler Weekend Package (20 runs) \$120

No more than 50% of trial fees can come from coupons/Jumping Bucks.

Late fee \$10 per dog if received after March 7, 2024

If you have never done NADAC before, or it has been over 3 years since you have done NADAC, we are offering a welcome to the venue deal where you can enter all classes each day for 50% OFF your entry. It is only valid for your first time at a NADAC trial as the handler for those that haven't done NADAC in over 3 years. New dogs under a handler who has done NADAC before are not eligible.

Lodging Info and Directions:

This event will be held outdoors on grass with little shade. Public restrooms with water are available. You will need to provide shade for your dog(s).

SETUP

- Setup is on Friday beginning at 12:00 PM.
